Our Lady's Green Scapular: A Miraculous Little-known Sacramental for Healing and Conversion By ChurchPOP Editor - May 28, 2021



Have you heard of the Green Scapular of the Immaculate Heart?

Our Lady gave us this little-known sacramental through Sr Justine Bisqueyburu of the Daughter of Charity of St Vincent de Paul. After several visions, Our Lady presented the Green Scapular on September 8, 1840.

Our Lady appeared with her heart engulfed in flames in one hand and the scapular in the other. The scapular of green cloth was attached to a green cord.

One side of the scapular displayed her apparition. The other side depicted a heart set ablaze and pierced with a sword, with rays more brilliant than the sun and clearer than crystal.

Inscribed in an oval around our Lady's heart were these words: "Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us now and at the hour of our death."

At the time of the apparition, Sr Justine heard interiorly that the scapular "should be shared with the world as an instrument in the conversion of souls." **Continued.......**

Pope Pius IX approved this sacramental in 1863 and again in 1870. He said, "Write to these good Sisters that I authorise them to make and distribute it."

A priest should bless the scapular and the devotee should wear it, saying the inscribed prayer regularly and with confidence.

To help another person obtain grace, the devotee may secretly place the scapular in a home, for example, and pray the inscribed prayer with confidence for the individual.

Here's a story about how one man discovered the miraculous Green Scapular:

"Let me tell you the story of how I discovered the Green Scapular. This is my only way to spread a true and tender love of Her Immaculate Heart and of paying my debt to her. Some years ago, before penicillin was in use, I was lying in a hospital very ill with pneumonia. I began to haemorrhage and the doctors decided to operate as a last resource. **Then a little nun game into my room.** "Father, have you great faith in the Mother of God, especially in Her Immaculate Heart? **If so, you can be cured."**

"How, Sister?"

"Through the Green Scapular."

"What is that?"

Four years ago, Father, I was operated on for cancer. I was so filled with it, that they just closed me up and sent me away to die. **Then I prayed to Our Lady of the Green Scapular**; grew tired of waiting to die and came back to work. **I am cured**, Father. Do you want me to give you a Scapular?

"Please, Sister."

"With that she put one over my head. A feeling of tremendous confidence poured into me and **the bleeding stopped.** Two days later, in the X-ray room, they asked me when the haemorrhage had ceased. When I replied that it was a matter of a couple of days, they expressed great surprise.

"You have a wound that is six months healed and there is no other mark."

"Today even the scars are gone. No wonder I speak of an unpayable debt to Her Immaculate Heart. Since then I have done everything possible to foster this devotion. To my great joy and amazement, those to whom I have spoken of the Green Scapular have become more zealous than I. Never have I seen the equal of the faith and confidence of these new apostles of Mary."

Lastly, there are those who want to make Me their highest goal every moment of the day. They strive to do all things without considering their own convenience or inconvenience. They try to do the better thing, as often as this does not hurt their daily tasks or interfere with their daily obligations. This last group are choosing Me by turning away from every earthly satisfaction.

They still take the food, rest, and recreation which they need, but they now do so for a new and higher reason. Before they did so for the legitimate pleasure and enjoyment which they receive from these things. Now, however, they take these things from a sense of duty to Me, because I want them to do whatever is necessary for a good day's work. These are the men who have succeeded in choosing Me in preference to all things. They are not content with giving Me glory in their life, but they seek to give Me the highest degree of glory possible.

He who seeks Me thus completely, finds My perfect peace, My firm and lasting happiness, and his own highest perfection. I am more than any earthly accomplishment, more than any human praise, more than any worldly satisfaction. Only cowardice, or misguided self-interest can make you aim lower than this high perfection.

According as you limit your love for Me, will you have self-deception, spiritual poverty and discontent. The less you seek My love and friendship, the more do you harm yourself. You yourself will be limiting My generosity with you, because you will not use all of my wonderful grace which I desire to give you.
